

Employee Contact Tracing Tool

Speed the identification of affected workers.

When someone is infected with a communicable disease, quickly identifying the people with whom they have been in contact is critical. In the workplace, this process can be cumbersome without visibility into who was working when and with whom. Having a tool to rapidly identify employees who may have come in contact with an afflicted individual is key.

Kronos® is now offering an Employee Contact Tracing Tool to help organizations identify potential contacts. The tool uses employee timeclock entries that have already been collected by a Kronos system to help identify potential contacts who were working at an identified location at the same time as the afflicted employee.

The contract-tracing tool is easy to use. Simply enter an employee's ID number, the locations of interest, and the date range to be searched. All employees meeting those criteria who clocked in during that time will be listed. No health-related information is required or utilized in compiling the report.

Contact Tracing Steps

- »STEP 1 Contact identification: Once notified of a presumed or positive diagnosis, identify anyone in contact with an afflicted person since illness onset.
- »STEP 2 Contact listing: All persons identified as having had contact with the afflicted person should be listed as contacts and notified.
- »STEP 3 Contact follow-up: Regular follow up should be conducted with all contacts to monitor for symptoms and test for signs of infection.
